- Apply concepts of basic shop math, calculate figures and amounts such as area, circumference, distance
- Supervise and train personnel, directing them to accomplish specific tasks on a daily basis
- Adapt to a fast-paced environment, multi-task, prioritize, and apply troubleshooting skills
- Work outside in all weather conditions
- Work overtime and weekends periodically
- Travel occasionally
